Fill tank with water then add product. Shake & pour into clean sprayer. We recommend spraying all grassy areas, under shrubs, up to 30ft of wooded areas, wood piles, leafy areas and anywhere on property where it is shaded and moist. Can also be sprayed directly on swing sets and patios. Apply every 30-60 days depending on severity of infestation. 128oz of concentrate makes approx 100 gallons of ready to use. Do not dilute more than recommended. You and your customers will enjoy the pleasant scent of cedar and not have to worry about toxins or contamination.
